

TERMS FOR FIREARM SALES

- 1.** Firearms are sold either for the full purchase price or using the six months' payment agreement option. The agreement contract for this option will be provided to the Customer and signed by both parties when using this platform.
- 2.** Any special orders (not in stock at Leisure & Adventure) require payment in full, or as agreed, before Leisure & Adventure can arrange to procure the said firearm.
- 3.** The Customer will only receive the licence application form (SAPS 271) if 20% or more of the price payment has been received by Leisure & Adventure, when using the six months' payment option.
- 4.** Ownership of the firearm passes to the Customer with full payment of the purchase price and upon the firearm being taken into stock at Leisure & Adventure. Leisure & Adventure will only hand the firearm over upon presentation of a legally issued firearm licence or authorisation permit and after receiving the balance when using the six months' payment option.
- 5.** Leisure & Adventure will not charge any storage fees while licence applications are pending. Should the Customer fail to successfully apply for the licence within the period of ten (10) months, Leisure & Adventure will have the right to charge a storage fee of R200.00 per item per month as per the invoice or charges necessary to insure the Goods. This will apply from the first month after the ten (10) month period as Leisure & Adventure reserves the right to recover costs (such as storage fees, maintenance, etc.)
- 6.** Should the Customer fail to successfully apply or appeal for a firearm licence for a period of 6 (six) months, Leisure & Adventure undertakes to pay back the amount to the Customer minus the non-refundable deposit (20%) within a period of 30 (thirty) days into the nominated bank account of the customer via EFT. The Customer is, however, obliged to provide written reasons why he/she failed to successfully apply for a firearm licence.
- 7.** Notwithstanding this, should a licence application be refused for whatever reason, and a subsequent appeal also fails, Leisure & Adventure may refund the purchase price of normally-stocked firearms, less a 15% restocking fee.
- 8.** The Customer must supply documentary proof that the licence application has been submitted, or that the licence application has been officially cancelled, or that the licence application was refused by the SAPS (e.g. the refusal letter).
